Turkey, by promoting the alliance of civilizations and advancing its EU membership process, will continue to serve the purpose of a united Europe with multiculturalism, diversity, as well as mutual respect and tolerance.

This tragedy is not only national but a global phenomenon and shows that terrorism is scourge of our age, which requires international fight and enhanced cooperation at the European level.

On behalf of the Turkish people and my own behalf, I would like to extend my heartfelt condolences and deepest sympathy to Your Excellency, to the families of the victims and to the friendly people of Norway.
